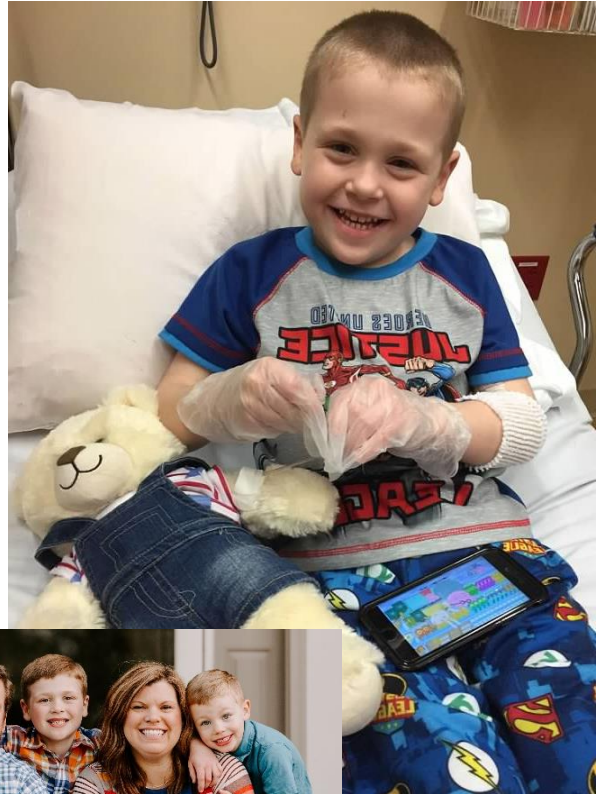
Noah

B-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia

Noah was diagnosed with B-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia at age four. He's currently seven years old and will be done with treatment in May of 2020. We're lucky because the chemotherapy is doing its job and killing the bad cells. We've seen how things can be different for other families. And although we feel blessed that Noah's treatment is working, it's been heartbreaking to see what his little body, mind and spirit have gone through over the past two and a half years.

Over the course of Noah's three and a half years of treatment, he will have had 1,076 doses of chemo, 192 days of steroids, and 20 spinal taps.

Despite treatments, Noah is an active 7 year old boy who enjoys learning and being creative, is a great friend/brother, and loves playing hockey, soccer and being outside. He was part of the campaign last year, supporting the Student of the Year Winner throughout her campaign. Noah is an avid sports fan who cheers especially hard for the Badgers.
